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SUNSCREEN APPLICATION

The weather has changed and during warmer temperatures we always want to protect the children from the sun. The health department suggested that the best protection from the sun is to wear long sleeves and pants while outdoors. However, when temperatures are extreme, long sleeves and pants may not be practical. In accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), it is our policy at the Child Development Center is to apply sunscreen with SPF 15 or higher.

Please apply sunscreen to your child every morning before dropping off. Your child's care provider will assist with applying sunscreen to bare surfaces including the face, tops of ears and bare shoulders, arms, legs, and feet 15-30 min before outdoor activity. A record of the application will be maintained in your Family Data File. Sunscreen will be applied after nap time, 15 minutes before the children go outdoors. It is the parent's responsibility to apply sunscreen in the morning. If you would like to use another brand of sunscreen, please bring it in and we will label it with your child's name and apply it accordance with the label directions.

Sunscreen will not be applied to any broken skin or if a skin reaction has been observed. Any skin reaction observed by staff will be reported promptly to the parent/guardian.
