# Uniform Complaint Procedure

## Annual Notice

It is the intent of Associated Students, Incorporated (ASI) California State University Dominguez Hills (CSUDH) Child Development Center to fully comply with all applicable State and Federal laws and regulations.

Individuals, agencies, organizations, students and interested third parties have the right to file a complaint regarding ASI CSUDH Child Development Center alleged violation of Federal and / or State Laws. This includes allegations of unlawful discrimination (Education Code 200 and 220 and Government Code Section 11135) in any program of activity funded directly by the state of receiving Federal or State financial assistance.

Complaints must be signed and filed in writing with the State Department of Education (CDE) or California Department of Social Services (CDSS) and mailed to:

If Complaint is not satisfied with the final decision of the California Department of Education or California Department of Social Services, remedies may be available in Federal or State Court. The complainant should seek the advice of any attorney of their choosing in the event.

A complainant filing a written complaint alleging violations of prohibited discrimination may also pursue civil law remedies, including, but not limited to injunctions, restraining orders, or other remedies or orders.
